


#### **April News from Wisconsin's Green Fire**

announced it is seeking
public input on the next
10 years of wolf
management in
Wisconsin and the fall
2021 wolf harvest. The
public comment period
will be open from April
15th to May 15th during
which an online input tool

will available on the **DNR Wolf management plan webpage** to submit comments.

As part of the management plan revision process, the WDNR will convene a Wolf Management Plan Committee (WMPC). Following the public comment period on wolf management's future in Wisconsin, the WMPC will provide input to the WDNR for developing an updated wolf management plan.
