Assess Contamination

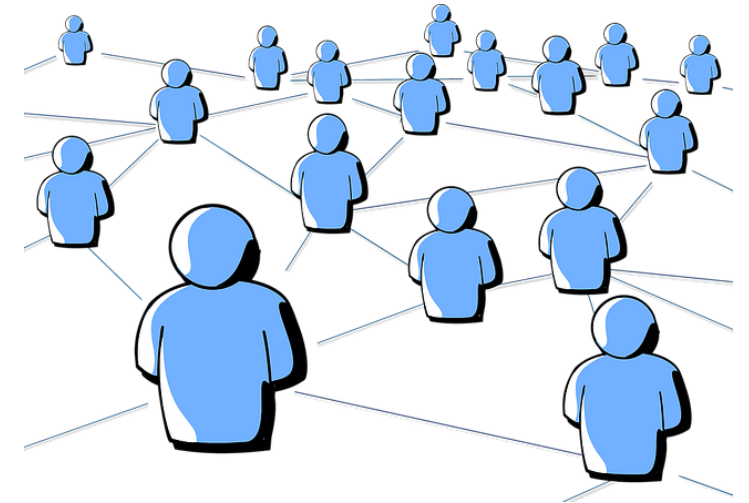
- Sampling
